Cooking

- ____ Never leave cooking unattended.
- Cuff sleeves and turn pot handles inward when cooking to avoid burn injuries
- ____ Never store combustibles in oven or on top of stove
- ____ When barbequing, move unit away from the house
- ____ Dispose of coals/ashes in metal containers

Smoking Materials & Candles

- ____ Never leave cigarettes or candle unattended.
- Purchase and use ashtrays that have the center support feature
- ____ Empty ashtrays into noncombustible containers only Never smoke in bed.
- Place candles in noncombustible, sturdy holders
- ____ Keep matches and lighters out of reach of children

Smoke Alarms

- ____ Install smoke alarms inside and outside every sleeping area and on every level of your home
- Test smoke alarms once a month Hint: use a broom handle to reach & push test button.
- ____ Replace smoke alarm batteries once a year Hint: use Daylight Savings Time as a reminder
- ____ Replace smoke alarm units every 10 years

Fire Extinguishers

- ____ Purchase a multipurpose (ABC) extinguisher
- ____ Teach your family how to use a fire extinguisher (Use P.A.S.S.: <u>P</u>ull the pin, <u>A</u>im, <u>S</u>queeze, <u>S</u>weep)
- Inspect extinguishers annually

Develop & Practice A Home Escape Plan

- ____ Develop a home escape plan that includes:
 - Crawling low under smoke
 - Two exits out of every room
 - A meeting place outside (tree, mailbox, etc.)
 - Practice escape plan with every member
- ____ Teach all family members how to:
 - Dial 9-1-1 in an emergency
 - (State your name, location & type of emergency)
 - Stop, drop, and roll if clothes catch fire

Exterior

- ____ Make house number visible from street
- Keep trees away from electrical wires
- Trim trees away from chimney and remove all pine needles and leaves from roofs, eaves & rain gutters.

Heating Equipment & Fireplace

- Keep space heaters at least 3 feet away from all combustibles
- ____ Replace furnace filters once a year
- ____ Clean lint from behind clothes dryer
- Install a spark screen in front of the fireplace
- ____ Have chimney inspected and cleaned annually
- ____ Install a spark arrester on chimney
- ____ Dispose of ashes in metal containers
- Keep newspapers, other combustibles and clutter away from water heater

Electrical

- ____ Avoid overloading electrical circuits
- ____ Inspect electrical cords and appliances for damage
- ____ Do not tack cords to the wall or run them under rugs.
- ____ Maintain air space around electrical equipment, such as, TV, DVD, stereo, etc.
- Install additional outlets, by a qualified electrician, to avoid using power strips and extension cords
- If you must use extension cords, use only the kind that have a built-in circuit breaker (surge protector)

Flammable Liquids & Hazardous Materials

- ____ Limit the amount of chemicals stored
- ____ Dispose of and recycle household hazardous materials properly (see below)
- Store hazardous materials in proper containers with tightfitting lids and correct identification labels
- ____ Store hazardous materials away from heat sources
- ____ Allow for proper ventilation when using flammable liquids and hazardous materials
- Put oily rags in metal containers with tight-fitting lids, not in a pile where they can spontaneously ignite.
